
8' Walk Thru ADA Table

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Parts Included:



2 – 3/8" x 3" Stainless Steel Bolt

 $1 - 3/8'' \times 3 1/2''$ Stainless Steel Bolt 6 – 3/8" Stainless Steel Washers

Hardware Included:

- 3 3/8" Nylon Lock Nuts
- 21 5/16" x 6" Stainless Steel Lag Screws 21 – 5/16" Stainless Steel Washers



5/16" Drill Bit (6" or longer) Power Drill or Screw Gun





Walk Thru Legs (3)

Leg Braces (2)

Build the table on a flat or level surface.

Step 1 – Place the table on a flat, clean surface with the table top side down. You may want to place cardboard underneath to help keep clean and prevent scratching the top. Take the three Walk Thru Legs and place upside down in between the 2" x 2" runners and metal framing attached to the table top. Make sure to center the Walk Thru Legs with the table top. Shown Below along with Step 2.



Step 2 – Attach the two Leg Braces to the three Walk Thru Legs using the pre-drilled holes. Start with the outside legs, use a 3" bolt with a 3/8" washer through the predrilled hole, add another 3/8" washer on the other side of the bolt and a 3/8" nylon nut (the nut should be on the inside side of the leg). When attaching both the leg braces to the center leg, use a 3 ½" bolt with a 3/8" washer through the predrilled holes, add another 3/8"

washer on the other side of the bolt and a 3/8" nylon nut. Shown above and here.



Step 3 – The legs will need to be predrilled to attach the legs to the table top with the 5/16'' lag bolts. Drill three holes through the 2" x 2" runners and legs with a 5/16" drill bit. Do NOT drill through




both 2" x 2" runners.



Only through one 2" x 2" runner and the leg! Screw the 5/16" lag bolt with a 5/16" washer into each hole, attaching the legs to the table top. Repeat this step with all four legs. See photos.

Step 4 – Flip the table over and place the seats on the table legs, make sure they are evenly spaced over the leg. Repeat the Step above for predrilling holes (2 holes per leg for the seats) for each seat leg. Then attach with 5/16" bolts and a 5/16" washer for each hole location. See Photos Below.



Your Walk Thru ADA Table is complete!



If you get any scuffs or scratches on the table or seats, you can use a hand propane torch to touch them up by move very lightly over the area. Do NOT leave the flame in one area for an extended period or it will burn.
